Monthly Maintenance Tip Dishwasher

If your dishwasher isn't cleaning as well as it used to, we have a solution for you! Empty it out and take a half-filled medium sized glass with white vinegar in it, set it on the bottom rack, and run your dishwasher through its normal cycle. This will clean the internal parts of the dishwasher to make the cleaning cycle more efficient.

BACK TO SCHOOL: BE SAFE AND SMART

Nothing is more important than our kids' safety! Check out just a few tips from the National Safety Council as kids start the new school year.

Whether children walk, ride their bicycle or take the bus to school, it is extremely important that they take proper safety precautions. Here are some tips to make sure your child safely travels to school:

Walkers »

Review your family's walking safety rules and practice walking to school with your child. Walk on the sidewalk, if one is available; when on a street with no sidewalk, walk facing the traffic Before you cross the street, stop and look left, right and left again to see if cars are coming Make eye contact with drivers before crossing and always cross streets at crosswalks or intersections Stay alert and avoid distracted walking

Bus Riders »

Teach your children school bus safety rules and practice with them. Go to the bus stop with your child to teach them the proper way to get on and off the bus

Teach your children to stand 6 feet (or three giant steps) away from the curb

If your child must cross the street in front of the bus, teach him or her to walk on the side of the road until they are 10 feet ahead of the bus; your child and the bus driver should always be able to see each other Get the facts on bus safety from Injury Facts

Backpacks »

Choose a backpack for your child carefully; it should have ergonomically designed features to enhance safety and comfort. Ask your children to use both straps when wearing their backpack to evenly distribute the weight on their shoulders Don't overstuff a backpack; it should weigh no more than 5% to 10% of your child's body weight

Rolling backpacks should be used cautiously since they can create a trip hazard in crosded school hallways
